### Window 4: Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020

This fun challenge can be completed as small groups or as a whole class throughout the 2 week window. There are separate challenge sheets for KS1 and KS2.

#### Rules

- Select the correct sheet for either your KS1 or KS2 class. Cut out the 26 letter boxes from the alphabet sheet and space out on tables or safe area.
- For each letter, ONE object should be collected by the children, from the school site must be placed on the table next to the letter. For example, for the letter L the item may be a leaf. This must be placed on the table and 'leaf' written on the alphabet box. Please do not include any adjectives in your label, for example is a leaf is a leaf, not a brown leaf, or crunchy leaf etc
- The class must find items which can be brought to the table to be placed on the appropriate letter, Letters must not be removed from the table to be placed near or on an item. The area available for this challenge depends on the school site and areas available to particular 'bubbles'. Outdoor and indoor facilities can be accessed to find items. No staff areas or staff contributions from these areas permitted.
- All items must be found on the school premises. No items can be brought onto the school site to complete the challenge.
- Each item can only be used ONCE to fulfil an alphabet letter.
- As this competition is about participation, small groups can be asked to find items for selected letters, or more than one item can be provided per letter and the class decide which one to submit.

#### Scoring

- Only ONE entry can be submitted per class. A photograph of all items, including the appropriate completed letter boxes must be submitted via [www.letsgetahead.co.uk](http://www.letsgetahead.co.uk) by 5 pm on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Please submit as one document rather than individual photographs of items. A display on a table in one photo will be ideal.
- For each correctly identified item submitted, **2 points** will be awarded.
- If the item is unique and no other school in the key stage submits this as an entry, a bonus of **1 point** will be awarded for each item.
- Items with adjectives will not be awarded any points.
- A bonus of **10 points** will be awarded if a class submits a map, showing the location and label of where each item was collected from. This will be reduced to 5 points if not all items are shown on the map submitted.
- In the case of a tiebreak, the number of letters in all of the items will be counted and the class with the most number of letters will be the winner.

- Please consider the sanitising and appropriateness of items being collected and potentially being brought back into your classroom environment.
