Focus: Leadership



Window 3: Monday 19th October – Friday 6th November 2020

Challenge Creation is a team challenge where a group or groups of students create a physical activity challenge or a variety of challenges for another school to complete. This is a school – to – school challenge.

Rules

- The challenge(s) must be set via a video where students demonstrate and verbally explain the challenge. This must include:
 - A safe demonstration of the challenge.
 - A list of the equipment required to complete the challenge.
 - How can the challenge be made easier or harder?
 - How is the challenge scored? Is there a time limit? Is there a set number of attempts allowed?...
- The final video of each challenge can be no longer than 2 minutes in duration.
- There are 3 categories for challenges; Year 1/2; Year 3/4 and Year 5/6. For Year 1/2 staff can help explain the challenge and assist in the demonstrations.
- A group of students can only submit a challenge for their own year category. For example a Year 3/4 group can only submit a challenge suitable for Year 3/4 students from another school to complete.
- Schools can submit as many entries per age category as they wish.

Safety and COVID-19 guidance

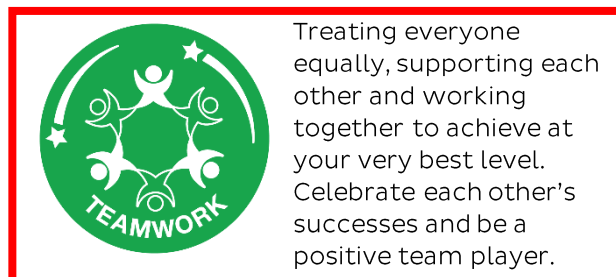
- Suitable clothing and footwear must be worn by all participants.
