

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Lost Participants/Abduction (contd)	 For the Swim; a timetable of heats for swimmers to complete the 25m / 50m swim will be issued to all schools on arrival. For the Run; the competition is timetabled clearly with all participants designated a start area. All participants must be escorted to the start area by a member of staff, who must stay until the race has been started. A staff member must be at the finish area to collect participants.
