

Communicate the fire evacuation procedure at the site to all persons present and the session participants i.e. the location of the exit route and the location of the assembly point. Schools should keep a participants list as this will be used to undertake a roll call at the assembly point. A mobile phone is available to contact emergency services. Cooperate with the owners/managers of the facility to ensure that fire / evacuation procedures are adequate, communicated and maintained. School encouraged to bring shelters, to provide shade. Schools should seek parents' approval and provision of sun cream. Sunglasses and/or hats are worn when they pose no danger to the wearer or other participants, depending on the activities.
