# Teams of the Year

- → Primary Male Team of the Year
- → Primary Female Team of the Year
- → Primary Mixed Team of the Year
- → Primary Small School Team of the Year (one form entry or <140 KS2 students on roll)
- → Primary Inclusion Team of the Year (SEND events)

Nominations are requested in each category for school sports teams who have achieved success in national competitions (e.g. reached the last 16 of a national competition) or achieved consistent success in local and county competitions. This could be winning a local Cet Ahead Schools event or competition.

# Sportspeople of the Year

- → Key Stage 1 Sportsperson of the Year
- → Key Stage 2 Sportsperson of the Year
- → Key Stage 1 Inclusive Sportsperson of the Year (SEND)
- → Key Stage 2 Inclusive Sportsperson of the Year (SEND)

Nominations are requested in each category for individuals who have achieved success in regional or national competitions or achieved consistent success in local and county competitions.

# Sports Leaders of the Year - sponsored by the Adam Simms Foundation

- → Key Stage 1 Sports Leader of the Year
- → Key Stage 2 Sports Leader of the Year

Nominations are requested for individual students who have dedicated numerous hours in a range of roles or sports, providing opportunities for others to take part in physical education and school sport. This could be playground leaders, students who support during PE lessons e.g equipment leader, warm up activities or students who help out at after school sport clubs. Multiple age and gender categories are available within this category.

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#### School Games Values Awards

→ School Games Values Award

Nominations are requested for schools who have demonstrated one or more of the School Games Values (Passion, Honesty, Determination, Teamwork, Respect and Self-Belief) within their personal sporting journey via participation or sports leadership.

# Ahead of the Game Award – sponsored by Consult QRD

- → Key Stage 1 Ahead of the Game Award
- → Key Stage 2 Ahead of the Game Award

Nominations are requested in each category for individuals who have demonstrated being physically active in a mixture of after school clubs, community clubs or at home, on a regular basis, exceeding the Chief Medical Officers guidelines of 60 active minutes every day. These individuals do not necessarily need to be top performers, just enthusiastic and dedicated to all things PE, school sport and physical activity.

#### School Sport Organising Crew/Committee of the Year

→ School Sport Organising Crew of the Year

Nominations are requested in each category for a group of students who have dedicated numerous hours in a range of roles or sports to providing opportunities for others to take part in physical education and school sport.

# School Sport/Activity Club of the Year

→ School Club of the Year

Nominations are requested for a school sport club which has had a major positive impact on its students within the classroom and beyond (behaviour, attendance, relationships, resilience). This could be a club which shares the ethos of young people being physically active to get more young people physically active but all types of school sport and activity clubs are considered.

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# Active Primary School of the Year

→ Active Primary School of the Year

Nominations are requested in each category for schools who have provided it's students opportunities within it's curricular and extra-curricular programmes and beyond to take part in 60 minutes of physical activity every day. Schools should also be able to demonstrate how they are promoting further physical activity beyond the school gates, to their student population.

# FA Girls Partnership Primary School of the Year

→ FA Girls' Partnership Primary School of the Year

Nominations are requested for schools who have provided extensive opportunities for girls to play football within intra and inter school competitions, Physical Education curriculum delivery and after school clubs. We are looking for schools who have pledged to provide equal access to Football and are committed to #LetGirlsPlay.

# PE Co-ordinator of the Year

Nominations are requested for PE Coordinators who have excelled in their role. They will have made a real difference and dedicated many hours to providing students from within their own school with school sport participation opportunities.

# School Sport Lifetime Achievement Awards

Nominations are requested for members of staff who have dedicated many hours to providing students from within their own school and beyond hours and hours of school sport participation opportunities. Staff should have dedicated at least 10 years of service to school sport.
