Teams/Gender:	A team consists of 6 young people. There are no gender ratios for a team. An eligible team member is any child on the SEND register (other than Emotional and Behavioural) including deaf and autistic children. If capacity allows schools may bring more than one team.
Event Format / Scoring:	A team will be allocated a lane for their team to bowl. One game of bowling will be completed by each team. Bumpers and ramps will be permitted. All balls will be provided by the venue.
