Teams/Gender:	Schools can ONE or TWO teams of 8 children from Year 3/4. Ideally there will be a mix of genders in each team, but this is not a requirement.
Event Format:	<p>The focus is on competitive opportunity rather than competitive outcomes. Children will be rewarded for demonstrating good personal and social skills, good movement skills as well as their rugby skills. The morning will consist of the team moving around a carousel of skills based activities, spending approximately 8-10 minutes on each one. In the afternoon games of Tag Rugby will be organised on small pitches. These will be in teams of 8 but 6 players will be on the pitch at one time. This will allow rotation of players and rest periods for all players. This will develop their catching, passing, evading skills practiced in the morning carousel and going forward with the ball and support. All equipment will be provided, but it may be useful if schools have their own tags and belts to bring them along. Activities will be supervised by student leaders from local secondary schools and/ or colleges.</p>
Scoring:	This is a non scoring development opportunity. The focus is on competitive opportunity rather than competitive outcomes. Children will be rewarded for demonstrating good personal and social skills, good movement skills as well as their rugby skills. There will be no final placings.
Results:	This is a participation event, so no results will be recorded. The event focus is about the development of skills and is non competitive.
Health & Safety:	At least one staff member from each school must supervise each team whilst at the event site. Schools are responsible for their own first aid requirements. Activities will take place on grass pitches, so please ensure children have appropriate footwear.
Target Group:	Boys and Girls from Year 3 & 4 with limited knowledge/ experience of rugby activities.
Intent:	DEVELOP: These events are for pupils who enjoy friendly competition but don't want to solely focus on winning or losing, instead they include a focus on the School Games Values, mass participation, enjoyment and improving.
