

# Round 2 - Bee Netball



## CATCH & PASS & MOVE CHALLENGE

How many consecutive passes can a class complete in your school?


### Rules

- A whole class must be involved. This can be any class in the school.
- All classes can try the challenge multiple times over the course of the 2 weeks, to see if they can improve their scores. But only one class' score needs to be submitted.
- Use either 2 or 4 cones to mark the layout shown on the next page.
- The class can be halved or quartered, and they stand in lines behind cones. (see diagram on next page)
- The cones should be at least 2 metres apart. If the cones are knocked during the challenge, pause so they are put back in the correct position and then continue.
- One child starts with the ball and must pass to the next person, they then join the back of that queue. The child who has caught the ball then passes to the next person and join that queue, this continues until the ball touches the ground.
- There is no time limit.
- A size 4 netball must be used for Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 . For Year 1, 2 and Foundation a size 1, 2 or 3 ball may be used.
- Bounce passes are not allowed. If the ball is dropped or touches the floor then the count restarts.
- Record the highest number of passes achieved.
- Please ensure you follow your schools guidance and ensure hands are washed before and after completing the challenge and if the ball is shared, this is wiped before being used by a different bubble.



Task 4	Submit ONE photo or photo collage to show a school or class playing Bee Netball Flier (Year 3/4), using adapted equipment as targets / goal nets.	1 point
Task 5	Can you attempt the 4 line challenge with two balls, starting opposite each other?	Complete over 30 passes for 1 point Complete over 50 passes for 2 points

An additional 10 bonus points are available to all schools each week by completing tasks and challenges. These could prove crucial in final league standings as the weeks progress.

### **When will the fixtures and competitions be announced?**

Your school fixture will be announced when your school receives details of the next competition

### **What happens if we win the league?**

A Trophy and a whole school event of your choice, will be awarded to the school who finishes at the Top of the League.
