

Dance Showcase

Teams/Gender:	Maximum number of 30 performers per school. Maximum number of 10 schools to participate per performance. Preference given to those schools who reply early.
Event Format:	<p>Arrival time:</p> <p>Morning performers should arrive from 9.15am, to start at 10am. Finish time will be 11.30am. Afternoon performers should arrive from 12.15pm, starting at 1pm and we will be finished by 2.30pm. Please ensure all your performers are ready as there will be no time or room for changing at The Baths Hall.</p> <p>Music: The dance should be accompanied by a track of music around 4 minutes in length. All music must be sent with wetransfer.com by Friday 23 February 2024 to katy.moore@baysgarthschool.co.uk. All music must be appropriate for the audience.</p> <p>Parents: Parents are invited to watch the showcase. However there is not an endless amount of seats. Therefore each group is allocated 30 seats for parents. (e.g. 2 groups up would mean upto 60 tickets are available.) They will be seated on the balcony for the whole show. Tickets will be £4 each. Schools will invite parents and collect the cost of the tickets. The school will then be recharged following the event. Should the school be inundated, please add these parents on to the reserve list as we may have additional tickets once we know how many are being taken.. Please advise parents, they will be unable to purchase tickets on the day, and only parents with tickets will be admitted. 3 adult places are allocated per school to sit with your group.</p> <p>Compere: A compere will take us through each showcase and will be supported by 2 children from each school to introduce their own performance. Therefore schools should choose and practice with 2 children to perform a short introduction to the school and how the performance has been developed, song, age groups etc. School should also provide this detail prior to the event for the compere too, he will help if we have a few nerves! Fancy dress allowed and encouraged.</p>
Target Group:	Any child from your school from Reception, KS1 and / or KS2 who would benefit from the experience of performing in a setting outside of the school environment.
Intent:	DEVELOP: Develop character and life skills; engage new audiences; foster social connections; support individual development in performance skills.
